Grant Summary

- ADVC Advisory Committee is comprised of more than 20 national organizations specializing in aging, disability and diverse populations and is poised to provide technical assistance and support
- Approximately 400 local organizations and eligible states mobilized at the community level to develop new or support existing vaccination response systems that will result in at least two million older adults and people with disabilities being vaccinated for COVID-19 and/or Influenza nationwide



Grant Summary, continued

- Focus: Reach older adults and people with disabilities most at-risk to negative health consequences of not being adequately vaccinated. Includes COVID, Influenza, Shingles, and Pneumococcal (pneumonia)!
- **Grant Amounts:** Generally range from \$50,000 to \$1,500,000 depending on programmatic reach and justified need.
- Required Activities: Meet all required grant activities either through internal agency operations OR in partnership with entities in your geographic area.

- Area Agencies on Aging (AAAs)
- No-Wrong Door Systems (NWDS)/Aging and Disability Resource Centers (ADRCs)
- Centers for Independent Living (CILs)
- Title VI Native American Programs
- Single State Planning and Service Areas/Territories
- Other ACL-funded disability networks
- Other aging and disability community-based organizations (CBOs)



Grant Activities

Vaccinations

- Community-based, and/or
- In-Home

Supportive Services

- Assistance to acquire appointments
- Transportation—arrange and/or provide
- Personal support to receive the vaccination
- Referrals to other needed services

Outreach and Education

- In-Person events (community or one-on-one)
- Phone calls, Emails, or Texts
- Social Media or other Web-based outreach
- Flyers, Mailings, etc.
- Newspaper, Radio, & TV Ads

Reporting Requirements

- Service Delivery Documentation
- Progress Reports
- Financial Reports



How to Apply to "Option A"

- Eligibility Screening
 - Agency Type
 - Required Grant Activities
- Application
 - Agency Information
 - Intended Vaccination Outreach Audience and Anticipated
 - Demographic Reach
 - Partner Agencies
 - Budget

USAging is reviewing and accepting applications on a rolling basis, so there is no application deadline.
